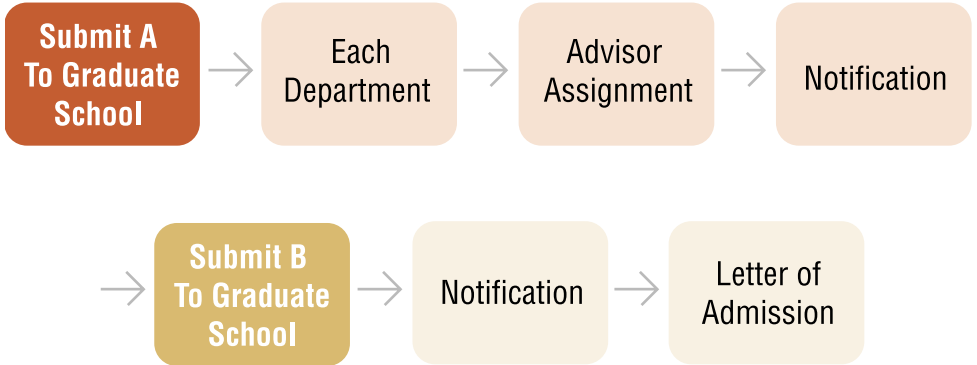

Founded in 1949 as a two-year college, Kyung Hee established a four-year university at the Seoul Campus in 1952. The Global Campus at Suwon opened in 1979, followed by the Kwangnung Campus in 1984.

Kyung Hee University offers the following scholarships to eligible international students.

Scholarships	Minimum Qualification	Support Scheme
KHS-A	a. Accumulated GPA of "A" b. "Excellent" Academic Record evaluated by KHU Scholarship Committee	a. 100% tuition waiver b. Stipend available by the advisor
KHS-B	a. Accumulated GPA of "A" b. "Good" Academic Record evaluated by KHU Scholarship Committee	a. 100% tuition waiver b. Stipend available by the advisor after 1–2 semester(s)
KHS-C	a. Accumulated GPA of "B" b. "Excellent" Academic Record evaluated by KHU Scholarship Committee	a. 50% tuition waiver b. Stipend available by the advisor after 1–2 semester(s)

Remarks:

- (1) The scholarship scheme above is subject to change without prior notice.
- (2) After the first semester, this scholarship will be available only for a student who maintains a minimum GPA of B+ each semester. In order for the scholarship to be applied, students must register for the semester.
